The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) will be holding a Public Comment Session on the Permanent Recreation Plan for the Conservation Easement covering the Speculator Tree farm and surrounding areas. Mr. Tom Martin from the NYSDEC Region 5 Office in Ray Brook and local NYSDEC officials from the Northville office will be presenting. The session is being held to provide the community with information about the terms of the Conservation Easement purchased by New York State and Interim Easement Plan covering the Speculator Tree farm and surrounding areas, and provide an opportunity to comment on the Permanent Recreation Plan for the area which is currently being drafted by NYSDEC.

The session will consist of a presentation by the NYSDEC about the rights acquired by NYS, rights remaining with the Landowners, and the rules for public land use in this area. Mr. Martin will also speak about the Permanent Easement planning that has begun and how they will be working with the Public to define this plan for the future.

The session will provide a chance for limited questions and answers following the presentation and conclude with the public comment session.
